





UNICEF 2019 IDAI Funding Requirements

FUNDS Total HAC: \$136M **REQUIRED** Flood response portion: \$122M Regional



\$4.9M

For Mozambique response (floods only): Total \$103 M req- 97% Unfunded

For Malawi response (8.3M reg for flood response): Total \$15 M reg-91% Unfunded

For Zimbabwe response (10.6 M reg for flood response): Total \$18 M req- 62% Unfunded

UNICEF 2019 IDAI Funding Requirements per country

FUNDS \$103M REQUIRED Mozambique HAC Appeal Funds \$3.5M

Flood response only

FUNDS \$15M REQUIRED Malawi HAC Appeal Funds available .4M

For Flood response: \$8.3 M rea

FUNDS \$18M REQUIRED Zimbabwe HAC Appeal Funds available \$6M

For **Flood** response: \$10.6 M req- 100% Unfunded
