Children now arrive punctually at school, the teachers are motivated and the children are happy. The enrollment of students keeps increasing, meaning there is need for more classrooms.

### School in a Box \$209.11

**Restart learning within 72 hours of a disaster.** Even in the middle of a disaster, UNICEF can get temporary classes up and running in 72 hours. We customize School-in-a-Box Kits for local languages and select basic educational supplies that can be used anywhere in the world. One School-in-a-Box Kit meets the needs of 1 teacher and 40 students to carry on classes for 3 months. Attending classes gives these students the chance to forget the devastation around them and focus on learning.



### Water Kit \$81.51

**The Family Water Kit helps families emerging from disaster provide safe water to their children.** One kit contains 20 clever, collapsible plastic water containers, which hold an impressive 10 liters of drinking water each; 500 water purifying tablets to prevent the outbreak of water-borne illnesses such as cholera and typhoid; and several bars of soap for washing. This grand gift helps 10 families protect and provide safe, clean water for themselves.



### Mosquito Nets \$40.80

**Malaria takes a life every 60 seconds.** Bed nets are the first and best line of defense against this deadly, preventable fate and can reduce the chance of children catching malaria by 20 percent. But many families that need them can't afford them. Your gift of Mosquito Nets provides 15 nets to protect children and families from malaria.



### HIV Test Kit \$117

**Every day, more than 1,000 babies are born with HIV.** Thanks to this test, HIV-positive mothers can give their children a chance to live HIV-free. Give mamma and baby a healthy start. This gift provides tests for 100 expecting mothers.



### Vaccine Carrier \$19.70

**Most vaccines require continual refrigeration to be effective.** The Vaccine Carrier keeps dozens of vaccine vials at the right temperature for 38 hours, even in the scorching hot weather. Lightweight and double-walled, they can be carried on foot over mountains, on a bicycle along dirt roads and in canoes across rivers.



### Super Hero Pack \$80.78

**Save a child's life.** No cape required. This miraculous pack provides Measles, Tetanus and Polio Vaccines (100 total); a Vaccine Carrier to ensure every precious drop of vaccine safely reaches a child in need; and 10 Mosquito Nets to keep disease-carrying insects from stealing precious lives. ●
