- Change for Good (CFG) is an innovative partnership between UNICEF and the international airline industry. Established in 1987, it is one of UNICEF's best-known and longest-running partnerships.
- UNICEF, the United Nations Children's Fund, has saved more lives than any other humanitarian organization in the world. UNICEF puts even the smallest amounts collected to work, helping to save the lives of even more children around the world.
- Currently ten international airlines support UNICEF's global Change for Good program, raising funds to save and improve the lives of children around the world. Since 1994, American Airlines has been the participating airline in the United States.
- American Airlines flight attendants, also known as "Champions for Children" have collected more than \$17 million in donations of foreign and domestic currency from American's customers for UNICEF's lifesaving work.
