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# Calling All Mentors

Virtually mentor a classroom on their UNICEF Kid Power Journey

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This spring, over 100,000 students across the country will come together to make their world a better place. With UNICEF Kid Power, kids go on virtual Missions to unlock therapeutic food packets for severely malnourished children around the world.

Whether you're part of a campus or community club or a team of co-workers, your group can mentor a Kid Power classroom during their UNICEF Kid Power journey. It takes just 30 minutes every two weeks for your group to let these kids know how awesome they are for being a part of this Kids Helping Kids® movement.

## How It Works

**1 Sign up.** Have a leader or advisor sign up on behalf of your group [here](#). Sign up by February 15, 2018. In late February, your group will be matched up with a participating Kid Power classroom.

**2 Virtually meet up.** From March through May, get to know your class and encourage their world changing activity during virtual meetups. We'll provide suggested activities and discussion guides, with little to no preparation necessary. Your group leader or advisor can coordinate with your Kid Power classroom's teacher to find the best time and method for connecting. We recommend a meetup once every two weeks from March through May.

**3 Celebrate during Kid Power Month.** As the school year comes to an end, celebrate the lifesaving impact your class has had in helping other kids around



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the globe. If you're in the same community as your Kid Power classroom, come together for a Kid Power Day and get active and save lives together.
